Ethical Upstanders[®] for Everyone

12 HOURS

This training is designed to teach students ages 6-18 awareness and skills for embracing diversity. The program includes the Ethical Upstander[®] curriculum in addition to an overview of diversity, equity and inclusion topics. Participants in this program will:

- ✓ Develop community agreements for respectful communication and engagement
- ✓ Identify commonly targeted social identity groups
- ✓ Unpack the “Girl/Boy Box” to understand gender socialization and potential harmful consequences
- ✓ Examine homophobia, transphobia and create strategies for non-gender enforcing practices
- ✓ Identify harmful behaviors including bullying, harassment, discrimination and assault.
- ✓ Learn the history of race and racism in the US
- ✓ Analyze prejudice, bias, stereotypes – how they are created, manifested and tools for un-doing them
- ✓ Consider the impact of anti-Semitism, Islamophobia and anti-immigrant attitudes and practices
- ✓ Learn and practice cultural humility
- ✓ Examine ableism and learn strategies for creating a accessible communities
- ✓ Create a template for welcoming, inclusive communities
- ✓ Gain tools for being an active bystander with scenarios and activities to practice skills
- ✓ Practice supportive communication and action toward those who are being targeted
- ✓ Utilize a template for “calling in” their peers who are causing harm
